Subject: Changes to Resets in Level III / Master Champion Classes

Dear NADSA Clubs and Exhibitors,

Effective for trials sanctioned after **December 31, 2024**, resets will no longer be permitted in Level III and Master Champion for the following classes:

- Lost Item Recovery
- Shed Dog
- Trailing & Locating
- Trailing Brace
- Urban Locating

This

This change aligns Level III / Master Champion competitions with the structure of Grand Champion and Challenge Games. Our decision was made to ensure more equitable competition for High in Trial awards and to help reduce the significant time resets can add to trial schedules.

Previously, clubs had the option to allow resets at their discretion. Trials already approved for 2025 that include a reset in their premium must honor those terms as published.

We recognize this adjustment may pose challenges for exhibitors managing multiple dogs; however, it reflects NADSA's commitment to fair and efficient trials for all participants.
